

## **Course Fee Structure**

### **Application, Materials and Course Fees**

Students will be required to pay an application fee of \$250 when they submit their application for enrolment. All enrolling students are required to pay \$1000 on account of course fee in advance, prior to a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) is being issued.

The following table shows the application fee & indicative health cover costs all international students need as part of the application for CoE. These fees are separate from the Course fees.

Students who are applying for enrolment and intend to come to Australia with their family need to make that information known at time of application as the Health Cover will need to be arranged for the students and their family. The fee for family cover will depend on the number of people applying. Please speak to Student Services when applying.

**Equipment Fees\*:** The Hospitality course requires equipment and uniform for the kitchen. The course materials will be provided by the college whereas the equipment and uniform for practical classes need to be purchased by the students. PCBT will guide the students about the places where it can be purchased and price for both uniform and tool box is \$400 to \$500 (approx).

\*please note: this is an indicative price only and subject to change without notice.

**Re-assessment / Catch up Class fees:** Students who fail to achieve competency will be offered an opportunity for re-assessment. Students will pay re-assessment fee at the rate of \$50 and \$70 for theory and practical respectively.

Students who fail to attend a class; PCBT accommodates such students by giving them an opportunity to attend the class. Students will pay catch up class fee at the rate of \$240 per week for Business courses and \$290 per week for Hospitality courses. Students need to re-enrol for catch up class if they fail to attend their regular classes.

**Exemption of Re-assessment / Catch up Class fees:** Re-assessment / catch up class fee will not be charged if a student has approved reason under compassionate/compelling circumstances.
